A cat's skin and coat are not just for beauty – they are important for health. **The skin** protects against the outside world, while the coat provides comfort and temperature.

Cats shed regularly, and their skin is exposed to stress from grooming, indoor air, or allergens. Omega-3 fatty acids (EPA and DHA) help keep the skin calm and reduce itching or irritation while Balanced protein continues to be important for strong hair growth. If cats don't get enough of these nutrients, their coat may lose shine, shed excessively, or become greasy. As cats age, their skin becomes thinner and less elastic, and the coat often looks duller. Seniors may also groom less because of dental or joint problems.

Omega-3s help **reduce low-grade inflammation** common in older cats while nutrients like chondroitin help **keep tissues flexible**, which also benefits the skin. Good nutrition in seniors can help them keep a softer coat, healthier skin, and a more youthful appearance. High quality protein, essential fatty acids, and the right vitamins and minerals are key to keeping skin strong and coats glossy.

A glossy coat and healthy skin are signs of good nutrition. Our Skin & Coat formula combines omega-3 fatty acids, chondroitin sulphate, and vitamin B7 (biotin) to **nourish the skin and restore coat softness and shine**.

Biotin supports regeneration at the cellular level, while chondroitin and omega-3s help **maintain skin elasticity and reduce dryness or irritation**. This functional snack keeps your cat looking and feeling its best, from whiskers to tail.



Hairball control Smooth digestion and comfort

Cats are natural groomers and can spend several hours a day licking their fur. Their tongue is covered with tiny, hook-like structures that act like a comb, catching loose hairs. While most of these swallowed hairs pass safely through the digestive system, some can **collect in the stomach and form hairballs**.

For many cats, this is a normal process, but when too much hair builds up, it **can cause discomfort**. Signs include coughing, gagging, constipation, or even vomiting up compact balls of fur. Long-haired breeds, older cats that groom more, or cats that shed heavily are especially prone to hairballs.



One of the most frequent conditions is **Feline Lower Urinary Tract Disease (FLUTD)**, which includes **inflammation, crystal formation, and sometimes urinary blockages.** These problems are not only painful but can become life-threatening if left untreated. Signs include frequent urination, straining in the **litter box, or blood in the urine** — all of which are alarming for pet parents.

Formulated to promote urinary tract comfort, our **Urinary Support snacks** combine **omega-3 fatty acids with chicory derivatives** rich in inulin. Omega-3s help reduce inflammation and support the mucosal lining of the bladder, while inulin acts as a prebiotic to maintain a balanced gut and urinary microbiota. Together, these nutrients encourage optimal urinary health and reduce the risk of recurring discomfort.

Obesity is one of the most common health problems in domestic cats today. Studies suggest that 30–40% of pet cats are overweight, and many owners don't even realize their cat is carrying extra weight. Because cats are naturally small animals, even a little excess weight can have a big impact on their health. Extra weight puts stress on joints, makes movement harder, and reduces a cat's willingness to play or exercise — which can create a vicious circle of less activity and more weight gain. Obesity also increases the risk of serious conditions such as diabetes, heart disease, urinary problems and liver disease. Senior cats are especially vulnerable, as their metabolism slows down with age.

Maintaining a healthy weight is **essential for long-term wellness**. Our Weight Support snacks feature omega-3 fatty acids, spirulina, and a tailored vitamin-mineral complex to help manage metabolism and satiety.
